Indoor and Outdoor Archery

(Caters for 12 archers maximum)

BASIC REQUIREMENTS		
1	INDOOR RANGE: Dimensions: 17m wide x 22m deep	Lighting, adequate to clearly light up target wall Seating at end opposite targets
1	OUTDOOR RANGE: Dimensions: 45m wide x 127 m	Flat, mowable (grass must be short so arrows can be found)
1	MEMBERSHIP: Irish Amateur Archery Association	Club membership includes insurance and access to National competitions, coaching and
6	Bows	(20-25 lb recurve with rest; 5 right, 1 left)
46	Arrows	Archers shoot 3 arrows each turn (end)
4	Targets butts	Square foam or straw; 2-4 archers per target indoor and outdoor use
4	Target stands	For indoor and outdoor use
6	Outdoor Individual Bow stands	Individual stands to stick in ground
20	Target faces (60 cm. 10-ring FITA paper)	To be replaced depending on usage
1	Bow Frame (optional)	Frame to hold bows off the ground when not in use
6	Quivers	Side hanging
6	Armguards	Adjustable
6	Finger tabs	5 right, 1 left
6	Sights	
100	Target pins	To pin up target faces
20 m	Backstop Safety Netting plus stand/wire support	For hanging behind targets to prevent arrow damage if an archer misses the target
4	Indoor Target numbers (on wall)	To be painted with stencils on wall
4	Indoor Target numbers (at line)	To be painted with stencils on floor
10	Outdoor Target numbers (on boards at target stands)	To be painted with stencils on wood
10	Outdoor Target numbers (on small boards at line)	To be painted with stencils on wood
18	Outdoor Distance numbers	To be painted with stencils on wood
4	Chairs	White, plastic
2	Whistles	

100 Scorecards (1 per archer per class period) To be designed, printed; plain paper needed

EQUIPMENT REPAIR SUPPLIES:

1 Archery accessory box To keep supply of vanes, nocks, etc.
1 Fletching Jigs for putting vanes on arrows
1 Serving jig To put serving on bowstring
100 Nocks For arrows; replacements
200 Vanes Marco Vanes; replacements
20 Rests Stick-on rests; black; replacements
6 Strings Fast Flight; black; replacements
2 Stringers To help with attaching strings to bows
2 Fletching glue tubes Gel for attaching vanes to arrows
1 Nocking plyers For attaching nock locators to bow strings
12 Nock locators Replacements
30 Points For carbon arrows; glue in; replacements
1 Bow-square Keeps measurements consistent
1 roll Serving string Dacron, replacements
1 roll Serving string Fast Flight, braided, replacements
1 Serving tools To put servings on bow string
1 Wax To wax strings
1 Archery accessory box To keep supply of vanes, nocks, etc.
1 Pencil sharpener

1 display board For list of notice, names, information, etc.

36"x48" cork board; push pins
1 Whiteboard 3ft x 4ft to hang on hut outdoors and indoors for scoring
2 sets Dry erase markers and erasers

T-shirts To be designed, printed; various sizes
50 m Rope Various uses, and to be cut to attach to target stands to prevent them from blowing over in the wind outdoors
4 Spikes 3/8" x 10" spikes to secure target ropes in ground outdoors
18 Flags 15" wooden dowels + colour fabric - Need to be made 3 different colours
1 Outdoor Storage hut For equipment and target storage, 10ft x 8ft
2 Mallets To knock target stand spikes into ground

SAFETY SUPPLIES

2 Tents 9.5ft.x 9.5ft. collapsible, portable
100 lb Chalk Line Sufficient to draw target lanes, shooting line, perimeter of area, etc.

1	Line Marker	For marking out the Field
370 m	Rope	To rope off perimeter, to attach stakes to stands, etc.

40	Stakes	4'-6" posts to hold rope for perimeter
1	Water dispenser with tap	with spout
1	Large cooler	with ice for cold drinks, bottled water
400	Cups for water	Plastic cups
