IAAA – National Archers Classification – Recurve Division Edition 2.2 - June, 15, 2009 – valid for training meeting 2-2009

From direct observation and from past results, archers have been classified in 3 different groups, based on their present status of form or past results. The A group is basically the present list of those that may represent IAAA at international events this year. The B Group is made by those that have not yet shown to have reached top level or to be back at top level, but have shown to have a potential of rapid growth for inclusion into the A level Group. The C Group is an entry level group that includes archers under observation since previous visits. All groups are open groups, and inclusion or exclusion in each group may vary during the year, based on results, new emerging potentials and any other unforeseen reason.

A Group (minimum FITA Score 2 x 1260=2520 or decision by National Coach)

A group members are those that have been recognized to be at top Irish level:

B Group (minimum FITA Score 2 x 1200=2400 or decision by National Coach)

B group members are those that have been recognized as having a potential to develop to the A group

C Group (decision by National Coach)

Remarks

An archer will be automatically included in the above groups A or B or move among them based on his results in the last 12 months (running total) as follow:

- 2 x FITA Round total
- 1 x FITA Round Total + 2 x 70/60 m Round total (Men, Junior men, Cadet Men, Cadet Women)
- 1 x FITA Round Total + 2 x 70 Round total + 40 points (Women, Junior Women)

The National Coach can include in groups A and B archers that have not reached the requested scores. Archers will be included in group C based on National Coach decision. Names of new archers to include in group C can also be submitted to the National Coach by the following authorized Coaches only:

- Pat Lyons
- Martin Victor Cunnigham
- Vincent Plant

Archers requested by IAAA to attend to the training meetings with the National Coach and failing to show up for two consecutive times without any justified reason will be excluded from groups. They then will subsequently be allowed to re-enter group A and B only by scoring in competition at requested level.
